

Streetlights at Khairabari

60 street lights have been installed at Khairabari in the initiative of Khairabari Town Development Committee under the guidance and close co-operation of Sri Lwmshrao Daimari, Hon'ble EM, BTC, Sri Maheswar Boro, Hon'ble MLA, Kalaigaon LAC, Sri Jagadish Sarkar, Hon'ble MCLA, BTC, members of ABSU, Khairabari, traders of Khairabari Market. Initially, the 30-bedded hospital at Khairabari Revenue Circle Office stretch have been covered under this venture. There is a plan to cover more areas.

As Khairabari is not yet a notified town, the Town Development Committee has decided to bear the expense of energy bill and maintenance from their own fund pooled @ Rs. 20/- per shop per month. Two (2) traffic triangles have already been built at two tri junction by the committee with contribution from capable public for beautification of the locality. There has been no govt. fund earmarked for these two schemes as yet.

Women's right to vote
